Zero-Waste Ergonomic Architecture for High-Retention Personal Care.

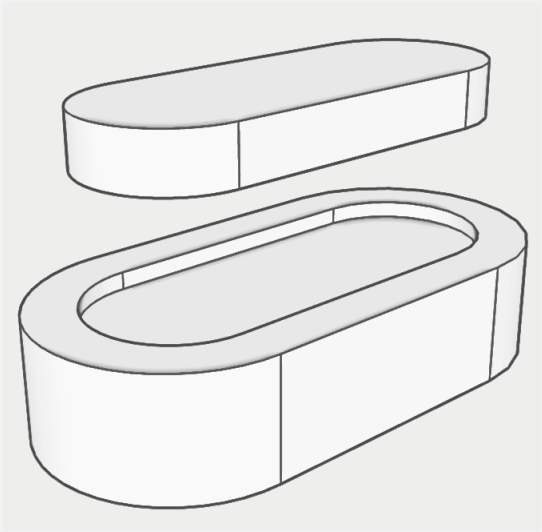

The Problem:

Traditional bar soaps suffer from a massive end-of-life efficiency flaw. As the bar erodes, it becomes a brittle, slippery remnant that breaks easily and is ultimately discarded by the consumer, leading to material waste. While consumers desire the sustainability of bar soap over plastic-bottled liquid gels, the ergonomic frustration of the "final piece" remains a primary barrier to brand loyalty.

The Solution:

A revolutionary, mathematically proportional interlocking soap bar system. The new host bar features an engineered receptive cavity on its upper face bounded by a perimeter rim. This universal female receiver is designed to securely lock and house a worn-down male remnant of identical initial geometry. Under standard showering conditions, manual pressure and moisture absorption trigger immediate mechanical interlocking and subsequent molecular fusion, eliminating product waste entirely.
